EMERGENCY PROTECTION FROM ABUSE (PFA) INFORMATION

If you need IMMEDIATE help for the night / weekend / holiday, then you can apply for an **EMERGENCY PFA ORDER** from a Magisterial District Judge that will be in effect until the close (5:00 p.m.) of the next Court business day.

WHERE TO APPLY FOR AN EMERGENCY PFA ORDER

1.) YOUR LOCAL MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT COURT

After 11:00 a.m. until the close of business. You may want to call and verify office hours.

2.) MUNICIPAL COURTS BUILDING

An Emergency PFA Order will expire at the close (5:00 p.m.) of the next available business day for the Family Court. To request an extension of an emergency PFA Order, you must appear in person at the Family Court, located at 440 Ross St, Room 3030, Pittsburgh PA 15219 at the beginning (8:30 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.) of the next available business day.
